NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Thurston Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 16621 on March 31st, 2026.

Ordinance 16621 renews / creates a Lake Management District for Lawrence Lake pursuant to Chapter 36.61 RCW, designates it as Lawrence Lake Management District No. 26, and orders the related lake improvement and maintenance activities.
